Native Plants: 1. Review plant life cycle and why transplanting is best done when the plant is "sleeping" (in the dormant stage). 2. Discuss meadow native plant garden and ask about plants that are already there with roots "hidden" under the ground (students may remember plants they have planted there) 3. Examine KŁO,EL (Camas, Camassia quamash) bulbs, student pick a few to transplant 4. Transplant KŁO,EL into meadow native plant garden 5. Elder talk about KŁO,EL harvest
